Ideally your background includes leadership, project management and maintenance planning within a plant, mill, or terminal operation where 24/7 uptime is essential. In addition, you bring a successful track record of maintaining PLC controls and electrical systems for related industrial equipment. The Maintenance Engineer will be a critical thinker and project manager with excellent leadership ability, communication skills and current knowledge of RTG and Quay Crane equipment. A Bachelor of Applied Science degree in Engineering with an Electrical focus is required and a P.Eng. designation is an asset.
