Short Description

As the Manager, Asset Management, you will collaboratively lead SaskWater's asset management and GIS programs and provide policy direction from an enterprise perspective. You will provide leadership, support, tools and training to other work units and will develop, implement and monitor preventive maintenance programs, warranty tracking, reliability and criticality analysis, predictive maintenance/replacement, etc. You will review both operational and equipment requirements to determine best practices and optimum frequency of preventative maintenance. You will collaborate with Construction Engineering to ensure asset structure and asset data is set up and entered into asset management system as new infrastructure is commissioned. You will be responsible for SaskWater's surveying and drafting programs. As a member of SaskWater's management team, you will lead and/or participate in asset management initiatives, financial planning and budgeting and special initiatives.

Job Duties

Oversee and manage the development and implementation of SaskWater's asset management program.

Oversee and manage the development and implementation of SaskWater's GIS program, including record drawings management and the issuing of plan numbers.

Coach and provide leadership and guidance to direct reports including performance, training and development, discipline, harmonious relationships and managing work assignments.

Manage the research, development, implementation and maintenance of a corporate asset management system and GIS system for water supply, water treatment and wastewater treatment systems.

Work closely with internal stakeholders to ensure consistency of asset management, preventative maintenance work, collection and compilation of data regarding the performance of preventative maintenance, warranty tracking, reliability and criticality analysis and predictive maintenance and/or replacement.

Routinely evaluate the preventative maintenance program and recommend adjustments and improvements to the program.

Perform occasional field work to acquire additional infrastructure data or to confirm accuracy of asset data.

Define, develop and report on key performance indicators.

Contribute to the development of SaskWater's Capital Plan.

Develop and maintain relationships with key stakeholders within the corporation to ensure a coordinated effort in program delivery.

- Valid Class 5 Driver's License
