

# Superintendent, Maintenance Port Hope Conversion Facility



## Position and Responsibilities

Reporting to the manager, maintenance and material handling, the superintendent will oversee all site maintenance activities to deliver prompt, safe, and efficient service to the various stakeholders on site. The maintenance department is responsible for fixed plant production equipment, facility maintenance, and mobile equipment maintenance. Responsibilities are diverse and will include but are not limited to; progressing asset maintenance & reliability best practices to enhance equipment uptime while ensuring that employees have the tools, training and resources they require to effectively support equipment at site. The successful candidate will champion and support the adherence of Cameco work identification, work planning, work scheduling, work close out and urgent work processes. The maintenance superintendent is responsible for ensuring ongoing compliance with all regulatory agency requirements, SHEQ standards, corporate policies and site procedures, including responsiveness to audit feedback. This role will direct oversee approximately 10 supervisors who in turn lead approximately 70 multi-disciplinary tradespeople and storekeepers. The maintenance team also is responsible for coordinating work by various speciality contract service providers at site.
