

A third certification, Certified Asset Management Assessor, is offered in association with the World Partners in Asset Management.



MAINTENANCE MANAGEMENT PROFESSIONAL

Leads to MMP Professional Designation

The Maintenance Management Professional (MMP) program provides training and certification to those aspiring to, or already in, maintenance management or supervisory positions enabling them to align their work with the Asset Management strategies and plans of the organization. For organizations that have not adopted a formal Asset Management policy or strategy, MMPs are well positioned to champion that development with their senior management and have the tactical knowledge to deliver results. Certified MMPs are qualified to provide cost effective management of a business's existing physical assets and to provide valuable insight into the decision making processes for future acquisitions. Graduates have the knowledge and skills to drive improvements in business processes, operational productivity, cost reductions, safety, environmental compliance, increased economic life of assets, return on investment and effective communication between departments.







ASSET MANAGEMENT PROFESSIONAL

Leads to CAMP Professional Designation

The Asset Management Certificate (AMP) program has been designed to build organizational capacity for excellence in Asset Management by developing relevant knowledge and skills in those responsible for Asset Management decision-making and design of the Asset Management system. The courses are relevant to midcareer professionals and senior managers from varied disciplines including especially engineering, IT and business/ financial. The program has been developed with reference to both ISO 5500x and the "Asset Management Landscape" produced by the Global Forum for Maintenance and Asset Management.





MAINTENANCE WORK MANAGEMENT CERTIFICATE

Professionals in maintenance roles can enhance their expertise by completing specific modules of the MMP education program. Completing Modules 1 and 6 of the MMP program qualifies practitioners for the Maintenance Work Management Certificate.

This certificate acknowledges their comprehension of integrated maintenance management strategies, work management principles, and maintenance planning, scheduling, and coordination methods.

GLOBAL OPPORTUNITIES & RECOGNITION

RECOGNITION FOR COMPETENCY IN ASSET MANAGEMENT

PEMAC, in collaboration with other members of the World Partners in Asset Management, has developed the Global Certification Scheme (GCS) that aligns credentials in Asset Management in Canada and around the world. The scheme provides a laddered career path for individuals who are looking to expand their skills and receive global recognition for their knowledge and competency in asset management. It also provides a structure which organizations can use to ensure that staff has the knowledge, skills and experience to apply asset management principles in various contexts.

PEMAC offers three certifications that align with the GCS:

- Certified Technical Specialist in Asset Management (CTAM)
- Certified Practitioner in Asset Management (CPAM)
- Certified Senior Principal in Asset Management (CSAM)


