PEMAC's Asset Management Professional (AMP) education and certification program is available for municipal practitioners. Teams from municipalities across Canada will take a learning journey together with the goal of meaningfully improving the Asset Management practices of their municipality. The AMP program introduces participants to the latest in strategic asset management thinking while building organizational capacity for excellence in Asset Management. Participants develop the capacity to engage others and build their knowledge and skills in key subject areas while familiarizing themselves with tools for strategic decision making at each stage of the asset lifecycle.

Designed with the Federation of Canadian Municipalities' Asset Management Readiness Scale in mind, and aligned with ISO 5500x standards, this special delivery of the program will allow municipal sector practitioners to strengthen their region's approach to managing its assets as they share and learn from one another, while also being guided along the path from plan to execution from leading Asset Management experts.

For a significantly subsidized tuition, teams of practitioners from Canadian municipalities will take the learning journey together. Participants who meet the program assessment criteria at the close of the program will qualify for the PEMAC *Certified Asset Management Professional* (CAMP[™]) designation. Through this capacity-building program the participants, the municipalities that they serve and the general public will win.

THE PROGRAM

The AMP program is designed for mid-career professionals and senior managers from varied disciplines including engineering, IT, business management and finance, who have responsibility for managing decisions with respect to the core life cycle functions such as design, selection, operation, maintenance of a municipality's assets.

Municipal sector practitioners from across Canada are able to participate in special delivery of the six courses of the AMP program starting May 2022 through November 2023. This initiative is offered through the Municipal Asset Management Program, which is delivered by the Federation of Canadian Municipalities and funded by the Government of Canada. Funding for the partner organizations' grants is provided by Municipal Asset Management Program (MAMP), an eight-year, \$110 million initiative funded by the Government of Canada and delivered by the Federation of Canadian Municipalities. The program provides asset management training, funding and information sharing to enable municipalities to access the data needed to plan effectively. MAMP is designed to help Canadian municipalities strengthen infrastructure investment decisions based on sound asset management practices. The program provides asset management training, funding and information sharing to enable municipalities to access the data needed to plan effectively.



Course 1 is delivered in a live online setting over five days.

Courses 2 through 6 are offered by 'asynchronous' online learning where participants are able to connect with instructors and other participants through the learning platform. Each of these courses are 30 hours plus additional coursework time, delivered over a ten-week period and will run from Summer 2022 through November 2023. Each course is broken down into "weeks" of work and supplemented with weekly online dicussions and supported by live Q&A sessions.

Successful completion of the AMP program leads to the CAMP professional designation. This designation qualifies for Continuing Education Units. The AMP program also provides the depth of AM knowledge required for the globally aligned CSAM certification, when coupled with an assessment of demonstrated competency in practice.
